

# **Council Highlights from the December Meeting**

Congregation Council met on December 14. Following are highlights from the meeting:

- Refreshments and fellowship were enjoyed for the half-hour prior to the meeting to greet the newly elected Council disciples. Those elected at the Annual Meeting are: Chip Baker, John Bandle, Debbie Byorick, Colleen Crozier, Elly Burns Frye, David Levine, and Doug Nelson.
- Property reported that the new defibrillators have been activated and the door inserts are being installed.
- Social Ministry reported that the Youth would be shopping for the remaining gifts on the Angel Tree.
- Evangelism is preparing for new members in early 2018 and matching them with shepherds.
- Worship and Music reported that the Ministry Team discussed the question of making changes to the current two services on Sundays. After much discussion they decided any changes would need much more thought and research. It was tabled and will be addressed later with Pastor Wollner, if needed.
- The Communications Task Force is working on several new additions: Flocknote, communication designed especially for churches; Sign-up Genius; a Facebook umbrella plan; and Twitter. Watch for details.
- A motion from Personnel was passed unanimously to offer the position of Pastoral Associate of Congregational Care (PACC) to Reverend Lori Carter.
