

Virtually every room of our community center will be used for this event and we will be providing snacks to all who attend, lunch for the volunteers, and giving tours of our bilingual pantry and soon-to-be-open Community Center in hopes of launching to the public later this fall.

Augsburg's Pastor Fisher was instrumental in helping get Christ Lutheran off the ground in the mid-1950's.
