


If you are interested in singing with the Summer Choir, please plan on attending rehearsals on Thursday, May 31 (6:15

With approval of the Congregation Council, Augsburg Lutheran Church has entered into an agreement to assist a building neighbor. The apartment building at 841 W 6th Street is having some drainage repair work done beginning May 21 and it is expected to last two months. During these two months, apartment tenants will have 24/7 exclusive use of 27 parking spaces in the northwest corner of the church lot on Pilot View. To make it easy to recognize the demarcation of these spaces, there are red lines painted in the lot between spaces 10&11, 29&30, and 48&49. Augsburg members and others should park on the Pilot View side of the red lines and the apartment tenants will park on the 6th Street side of the red lines. If

the project encounters delays, the agreement will be extended week by week. When the red lines disappear everyone will again be able to use all spaces. Thank you all for your understanding and cooperation. Augsburg Community Center Committee, Clarence Dixon, Chair

REFUGEE FAMILY UPDATE – Our refugee family, the Yusufs, will move to Minneapolis-St. Paul (MSP) in June, after the three school-age children finish school. They expect their fifth child in August. MSP has a thriving community of 40,000 Somalis and Sofia Yusuf's sister and family have resided there for a few years. They are very grateful to Augsburg for the friendship and assistance provided to them and have promised to stay in touch.

Caring for an Aging Parent?


