This July, join Mr. Bruce and Mrs. Leigh Anna for some fun, music, and learning during the Sunday School hour.

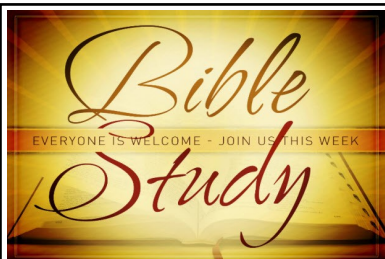

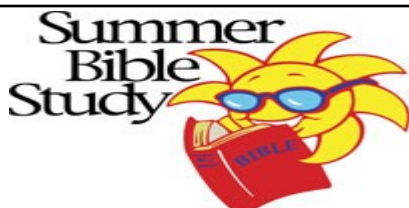

# Council Highlights

Council President Neil Linnell called the meeting of the Congregation Council of Augsburg Lutheran Church to order at 7:40 pm, Thursday, June 14, 2018.

The Social Ministry team highlighted its team members as well as their many outreaches all of which support our goals of expanding community and intergenerational connection.

Comfort Committee Loaves and Fishes Refugee settlement Stephen Ministry Overflow Homeless Shelter Shepherd's Center dinner	School and Personal Care kits Angel Tree Rescue Mission 5K Keeping in Touch Laundry outing for shelter guests
God's Work Our Hands -- We need your help to pack 10,000 meals for Rise Against Hunger.	

Stewardship Ministry team highlighted Stewardship for All Seasons that changes cultures from scarcity to abundance. The team asks all ministries to identify what we need in order to achieve our goals.

Youth Ministry team highlighted regular, dynamic Sunday nights when 30 to 40 middle and high school kids, advisors, and parents gather. Twelve people from the Middle School group will go on a mission trip this summer. A Winston-Salem group of 41 people from Augsburg, Christ's Beloved Community, and Epiphany will travel to the Youth Gathering in Houston.

Christian Education would like you to know about Children's Sunday School (scheduled for five Sundays in July), Day Camp: July 30 – August 3, and Summer Fun: Water Fun for Families June 29; Augsburg at the Dash July 14; Children's Movie Night August 14

Evangelism reminds you to greet ALL who enter for worship

The Augsburg Resource Tech team is working on plans to update our IT resources.

Council approved the following motions:

- All individuals who work with youth and children shall be up to speed with Safe Gathering. This is a NC Synod program that provides training, record keeping, background checks. Cost is \$35/person for three years and Augsburg's total cost will be about \$2,100.
- To provide support for Pastor Lori Carter's ELCA candidacy with regular communication, prayer, fellowship, leadership, and worship opportunities and the like.
- Use of Augsburg facilities in January 2019 for UNCSA high school organ competition
- Use of Augsburg facilities in fall and spring for violin recitals for disciple Suzy Perkins's students
- To support Pastor Wollner's participation in Leadership Winston-Salem, a cohort of new leaders, focused on learning about the community and networking. Cost is \$2,600 of which \$1,000 will come from CPE and the balance from other expense.
